The territorial limits of the University

The area known as Santiniketan in the District of Birbhum in West Bengal admeasuring¹[3000 hectares], bounded—

on the North by the Kopai River—

on the west by a line running from Ballavpur and Banuri villages to Bandgora.

on the south by a line running from Bandgora *via* Bolpur Dak Bungalow to the bridge over the²[Eastern Railway] cutting, and

on the east by the³[Eastern Railway] line.
