## EMBLEM OF THE STATE OF UTTAR PRADESH

## **DESCRIPTION AND DESIGN**

The State Emblem of UTTAR PRADESH is consists of a circular seal depicting the confluence of the <u>Ganges</u> and <u>Yamuna</u> rivers at <u>Prayagraj</u>, a pair of <u>Matsya</u> fish to represent the former Muslim rulers of <u>Oudh</u> and a bow and arrow to represent the Hindu deity <u>Rama</u> who was born in <u>Ayodhya</u> within the state. The legend around the seal translates as "Government of Uttar Pradesh". [2]

The Emblem of the State of Uttar Pradesh shall conform to the designs as set out in Appendix I or Appendix II.
