

NOTIFICATION  
INCOME-TAX

No. 664 (F.No. 404/48/74-ITCC): In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-clause (iii) of Clause (44) of Section 2 of the Income-tax Act, 1961 (43 of 1961), the Central Government hereby authorises Shri P.B. Choudhury who is a Gazetted Officer of the Central Government to exercise the powers of a Tax Recovery Officer under the said Act.

2. The appointment of Shri Asoka Maity made under Notification No. 199 (F.No. 404/74/72-ITCC) dated 10th October, 1972 is cancelled with immediate effect.

3. The Notification shall come into force with immediate effect.


